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






Global IT Spending & Growth for 2022




IT Databook Market Growth










Country Level IT Intensity




Inflation will remain high throughout 2022




- Inflation, global CPI will reach a decade high in 2022, unlikely to resolve before 1H23
 - Soaring commodity prices (1H22) followed by rising energy prices.
 Oil/Energy responsible for ~70% of inflation rate
 - Supply bottlenecks are easing in the US and UK, yet the war and another lockdown in China are worsening the situation in the EU, Eastern European and Japan.
 - Staff availability remains a challenge. Tight labour markets in many advanced countries will drive up wage rates and hence costs.




Average Sales Price Change from 2020






US Labor Market - Very Tight








Consulting & Implementation Services



- In 2022, CIO's will augment their internal skills by spending more on Consulting services (11.9% YoY growth)
- To support their digital ambitions, CIO's will invest in partnerships to create multiyear application & Infrastructure modernization roadmap.
- Commercial Application Implementation services will account for the biggest spend (\$133 billion) with 7.5% YoY growth.



Managed Services for Commoditized Tasks




- Infrastructure Implementation & managed services will record 2.7% YoY growth in 2022.
- Hybrid work & cloud are priority areas for CIO's requiring high demand of skills for;
 - DaaS
 - Managed services for Cloud and Edge
- Traditional Managed Services have more activity but declining spending
- WAN Managed services are transitioning from traditional delivery to Software Defined (SD-WAN)



Product Dominant


Usually professional services centered on the product (consulting/advisory), along with the product






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
